

Participation Guidelines

1. Information & Communication:

Once a person is interested in attending a Sacred Medicine Retreat, we provide informational documents about the Sacred Medicine experience.

2. Reading & Understanding the Provided Information:

Having read this aforementioned information, prospective participants make a well-informed and conscious decision to commit or not. In doing so, they understand the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual preparation required for an experience with Sacred Plant Medicine.

3. Establish Transparency in Communication:

It is important that participants express any doubts, concerns, and questions to us, the organizers, regarding the Sacred Plant Medicine experience. It is also vital that participants communicate with us about their physical or mental condition, as these might impact the experience.

4. Commitment to Living and Going Through With the Experience:

Once a participant decides to commit to the experience, the next step is to formalize their commitment and participation by making a deposit. This commitment includes staying for the entire retreat.

5. Deposit:

A deposit is required to secure a spot in our medicine retreats. The retreat invitation lists the deposit amount on the first page. This deposit has several functions:

a) It shows self-respect, as it gives certainty and conviction to the action or plan made. It shows respect to the retreat facilitators by providing the energetic exchange represented by money, and it shows respect to the other attendees who have committed to participating, as well as to those interested in attending.

b) It guarantees one's participation, reserves the spot, and demonstrates commitment.

c) It represents a responsibility with one's thoughts, words, emotions, and actions to fulfill an agreement. This agreement takes tangible form and creates an energetic structure in the timeline by being set to occur on the agreed-upon dates.
